

Having reopened with limited capacity, selected activities, and Grab and Go meals on June 14th, 2021, Catholic Charities made the decision to remain with this process until further notice.

As we look forward to the upcoming weeks, our hope and expectation is that we will be able to resume as much pre-COVID activities as possible; and we are anxious to welcome our seniors, consultants, vendors and volunteers back to the center. The duration of getting back to normal will continue to be guided by national, state, local health officials, Catholic Charities, DFTA and their respective guidelines.

Bayside Senior Center is preparing for all scenarios, with our preparation efforts focused on welcoming our community back to the center at pre-COVID levels. This includes the implementation of public health control measures such as new levels of social distancing, cleaning and disinfection, the use of appropriate personal protective equipment if any, along with other necessary precautions as part of the ever changing landscape of senior services. We will continue to work to maintain our commitment to excellence in serving our seniors within the community through the modification of our learning platforms as needed, and so doing, will continue to strengthen the overall positive experiences for seniors at Bayside Senior Center.

Queridos miembros,






親愛的會員




