MISSION STATEMENT

Catholic Charities in the Diocese of Brooklyn and Queens translates the Gospel of Jesus Christ into action by affirming the dignity and value of every person, especially the most vulnerable members of our diverse society. Catholic Charities develops effective responses to human need and joins with all people of good will in advocating for a social order which promotes justice and enhances human development.



As we look back on 2022, we experienced many wonderful achievements and accomplishments at Catholic Charities Brooklyn and Queens. We opened two new affordable housing buildings with the Pope Francis Apartments in Ocean Hill and the Bishop Rene A. Valero Senior Residence in Astoria, we opened the New Age Older Adult Center and celebrated the recently relocated Peter J. DellaMonica Older Adult Center, and we expanded our behavioral health programs and services to help even more of those struggling with mental health and addiction issues.

But 2022 was a difficult year for many of our neighbors as they dealt with rising inflation and rents, a lack of jobs and housing, and continuing fears and uncertainty over COVID-19. Fortunately, Catholic Charities Brooklyn and Queens was there to lend a helping hand during this time of crisis and uncertainty. The demand continues to remain high for our emergency pop-up food pantries and events, with lines of residents often wrapping around the block and more than 250,000 meals provided last year. Working closely with local parishes, we have expanded our food pantry network,

and we now offer 60 food pantries. Last year, we are proud to have been able to provide over \$11 million in food assistance to our neighbors in need.

Together with other nonprofit human service providers in New York City, we have also seen an influx of asylum seekers sent up from the Texas border during the past year. These recent arrivals desperately need food, shelter, and clothing as they arrive in New York City with only the clothes on their back. To meet their needs, Catholic Charities Brooklyn and Queens established an Asylum Seeker Program at two locations in each borough to respond to the crisis of migrants coming to New York City by bus. To date, we have served over 1,800 migrants, meeting their basic needs by providing them with a bag of food, clothing, toiletries, metro cards and Target gift cards. Information and referrals to our 60 parish food pantries and the New York City Shelter System were also provided. Our staff members connect the new arrivals with Catholic Migration Services' attorneys, who provide them with important information about removal proceedings, eligibility for work authorization and access to pro bono legal services. Our Moving Forward Program for new immigrants is also available to provide them with social service supports such as ESL classes and other services needed to navigate this city. In these difficult times, we are reminded of the words of Pope John Paul II to work "so that every person's dignity is respected, the immigrant is welcomed as a brother or sister, and all humanity forms a united family."

We also provided more than 450 children with backpacks and school supplies at Kids Fun Day, distributed more than 2,000 turkeys

and food vouchers at Thanksgiving, and provided more than 3,000 toys and gift cards during the holidays. Bishop Robert Brennan, who was distributing the turkeys here in the Diocese of Brooklyn for the first time, noted that the turkey distribution was part of the agency's year-round relationship with residents. "Catholic Charities, through our parishes and various programs here in the churches, is present to people all the time," he explained.

Bishop Brennan's words accurately reflect the mission and spirit of Catholic Charities Brooklyn and Queens. Through changing times and economic realities, we are here for the community on a daily basis. In a world of uncertainty, our neighbors in Brooklyn and Queens know that they can turn to us for the help they so desperately need.

I wish to thank our board of trustees, our community and government partners, donors and supporters for their dedication and assistance in helping us serve thousands of individuals and families throughout Brooklyn and Queens. With your support, we know we will continue to be a helping hand in uncertain times.

OLDER ADULT SERVICES

For seniors in Brooklyn and Queens, our programs are often a vital lifeline to their community. The newly relocated Peter J. DellaMonica Older Adult Center and the new Catholic Charities' New Age Older Adult Center both opened in 2022, offering healthy and delicious lunches, wellness and recreational activities, case management, educational workshops, exercise classes, games, art classes, health screenings, organized outings and parties. Our three Home Delivered Meals Programs continued to bring healthy meals to homebound seniors, and in 2022 Catholic Charities received \$490,000 in City Council funding to purchase seven new meal delivery vans. Our Social Adult Day Alzheimer's Program provided much-needed respite for caregivers caring for seniors with various forms of dementia and received an "Excellent" on a recent audit, with all service units meeting or exceeding standards.

OUR YEAR IN REVIEW

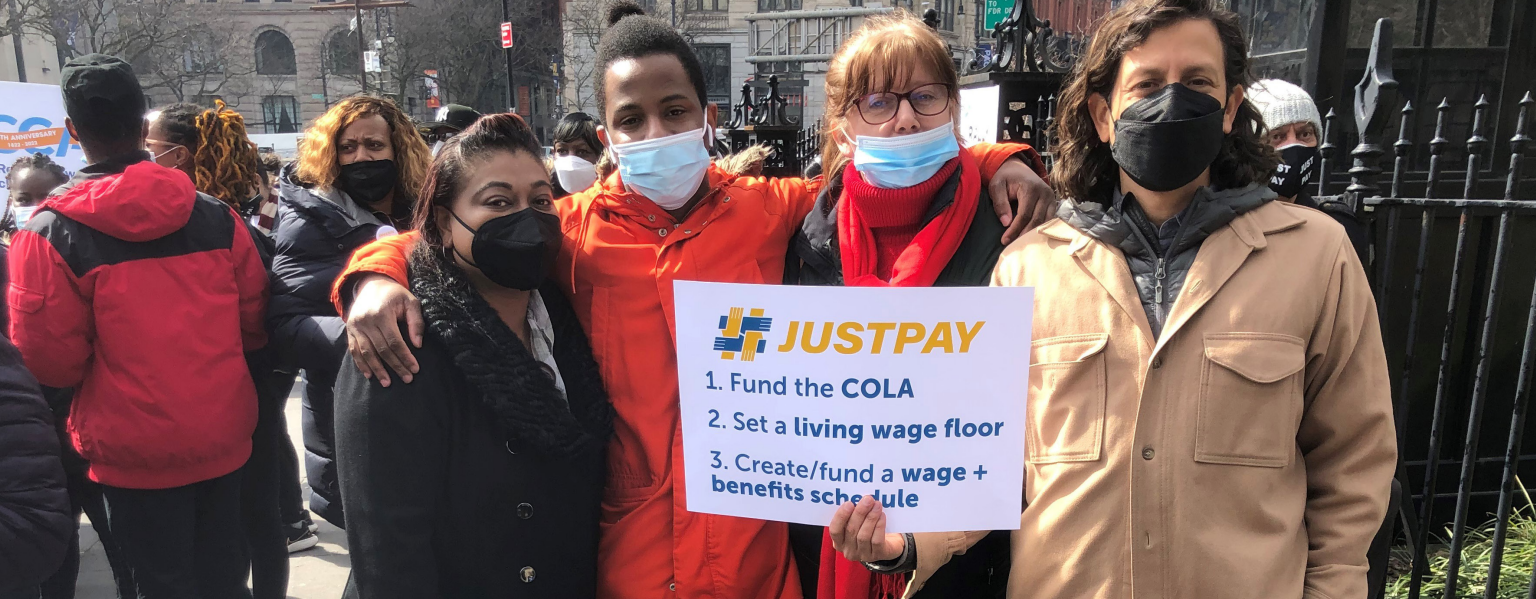
FAMILY SERVICES

Through the Queens Emergency Rental Assistance Program, which was created for households that were behind on rent and utilities because of the COVID-19 pandemic, staff members at Catholic Charities assisted residents with nearly 3,500 applications covering \$24.3 million in rental arrears and \$3.6 million for gas and electricity. In addition, more than \$7.8 million was provided as future rent through the state's Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP). Our Homebase Homelessness Prevention Programs served over 6,600 households with homeless prevention services including case management and connection to resources to prevent homelessness and maintain housing stability. Our Women, Infants and Children (WIC) programs in Woodside and Jamaica also had a very successful year with over 4,643 moms, children and infants enrolled, including 55 migrants. Through our Moving Forward Program, we assisted 1,381 mostly undocumented clients and provided 8,448 referrals. Due to the current immigration climate in the country, almost 80% of our clients arrived in the U.S. this year and are seeking asylum. The Moving Forward Program distributed Target gift cards and MTA metro cards to assist these vulnerable families and help them with basic necessities such as food and clothing.

EARLY CHILDHOOD SERVICES

Children enrolled in our Early Childhood programs regained developmental ground that was lost during the pandemic, with our child performance outcomes now meeting or exceeding pre-pandemic levels of performance. Children are exceeding expectations in social emotional development (61%), physical, literacy, and math (60%) and cognitive (59%). We continued to focus on engaging fathers, and more than 530 males took part in the Fatherhood Initiative Program in 2022. Male ambassadors participated in parent meetings and workshops, virtual open houses, Dad Bring Your Child to School Day and school readiness meetings. For our teachers, we made extensive curriculum revisions including video content and online learning modules as we launched the new and improved Montessori Teacher Training Center. In July, the Center celebrated the graduation of 12 of our own early childhood education teachers, who were the first class of student remote learning.





OFFICE OF MISSION AND COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Last year, staff members at Catholic Charities Brooklyn and Queens saw an influx of new and returning clients in need of help. Through the newly renovated Robert Charles Golden Community Outreach Center, staff members were able to assist 2,716 clients. Nearly 900 were helped with rental arrears, 336 with utility shut-off assistance, and more than 1,800 asylum seekers who were bused to New York City were provided with information packets, shelter information, emergency food, toiletries and metro cards. In addition to providing more than 2,000 turkeys and food vouchers at Thanksgiving and 3,000 toys at Christmas, Catholic Charities assisted more than 12,600 people through our health and wellness events with needed health screenings such as blood pressure, mental health, mammograms, dental and COVID-19 vaccinations. In addition, nearly 1,400 community residents were assisted with SNAP eligibility screenings, nutrition and parent workshops.

CLINICS, REHAB AND RECOVERY PROGRAMS

Catholic Charities has been awarded several competitive grants to help the mentally ill, those affected by COVID-19, people at risk for suicide, those affected by the ongoing opioid crisis, immigrants and the uninsured/underinsured. We received \$3.75 million in funding for medication-assisted treatment (MAT) prescription drug and opioid addiction programs, as well as \$3.99 million over four years for two Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinics in Flatbush and Far Rockaway to provide outpatient mental health and substance use treatment services to all individuals who request care, regardless of their ability to pay. Catholic Charities has also been expanding resources at the Rockaway Behavioral Health Clinic, which operates in the disadvantaged community of Far Rockaway, Queens. In 2022, we opened the Rockaway OASAS satellite to offer addiction services, making us one of only two providers of substance use services on the Rockaway peninsula.

AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Affordable housing is vital at Catholic Charities, and our Progress of Peoples Development Corporation has completed more than 4,567 units of affordable housing. In April, we dedicated the Pope Francis Apartments at Loreto. Located in Ocean Hill, Brooklyn, the Pope Francis Apartments provide 135 affordable apartments and case management for low-income and formerly homeless seniors, enabling them to live safely, comfortably and independently for as long as possible. In October, we opened the Bishop Rene A. Valero Senior Residence in Astoria, Queens. This newly constructed building features 102 affordable residences, with 30% of the building reserved for formerly homeless seniors with severe mental illness (SMI). The building also includes the relocated Catholic Charities Peter J. DellaMonica Older Adult Center on the ground floor. In 2022, in gratitude to Bishop Emeritus Nicholas DiMarzio for his faithful support of its programs and services, Catholic Charities also renamed the Pierrepont Residence to the Bishop Nicholas DiMarzio Residence. In addition, the Laudato Si Corporation, a nonprofit corporation that serves as a vehicle for administering sustainability strategies within our agency, went live in 2022, with three solar arrays installed on building rooftops becoming active in the summer months and residents already seeing savings on their utility bills.



RESIDENTIAL AND HOUSING SERVICES

Residential and Housing Services expanded its social services with two affordable housing buildings opened by Catholic Charities in 2022. Staff members now provide services to 31 formerly homeless mentally ill seniors at the Bishop Rene A. Valero Senior Residence in Astoria, as well as to 81 frail and elderly individuals at the Pope Francis Apartments in Ocean Hill. Both programs offer social service supports, assist with acquiring basic needs (food, clothes, utilities), prevent isolation and build a community among tenants, and assess for medical, mental health and substance use needs. The teams connect individuals to treatment, assist with applications for benefits and, most importantly, develop a support network for the residents during their later years, helping them age in place. Catholic Charities was also awarded a \$250,000 grant from TD Bank last year to assist those still affected by COVID-19, enabling two benefits coordinators to offer access to holistic care and wrap-around services to those in need.

CARE COORDINATION AND CASE MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS

Catholic Charities was one of eight NYC Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) teams awarded with a \$450,000 startup grant, enabling us to deliver treatment and social services to clients who may be street homeless, may have trouble traveling or may be hesitant to attend traditional doctor offices. Staff members also participated in successful advocacy efforts in 2022 for rate increases for Health Home Care Management services. Our status as a fully designated Specialty Mental Health Care Management Agency under OMH allows our Care Coordination Program to serve the Health Home Plus (HH+) population composed of complex clients with serious mental illness and substance use, homelessness, justice system involvement, poverty, medical illnesses and physical disabilities. In addition, funding from Cabrini enabled Catholic Charities to increase access to services for the uninsured/underinsured and increase benefits and entitlement work with clients.

CATHOLIC MIGRATION SERVICES

Since 1971, Catholic Migration Services has provided free legal assistance and Know Your Rights education to low-income individuals in need of immigration, housing and workers' rights legal services, regardless of race, religion, ethnicity, national origin or immigration status. In 2022, Catholic Migration Services helped 221 legal permanent residents become naturalized U.S. citizens and provided advice to more than 650 immigrants. Our housing attorneys obtained more than \$42,000 in financial benefits for low-income tenants and obtained back pay for 52 low-wage workers totaling more than \$650,000.

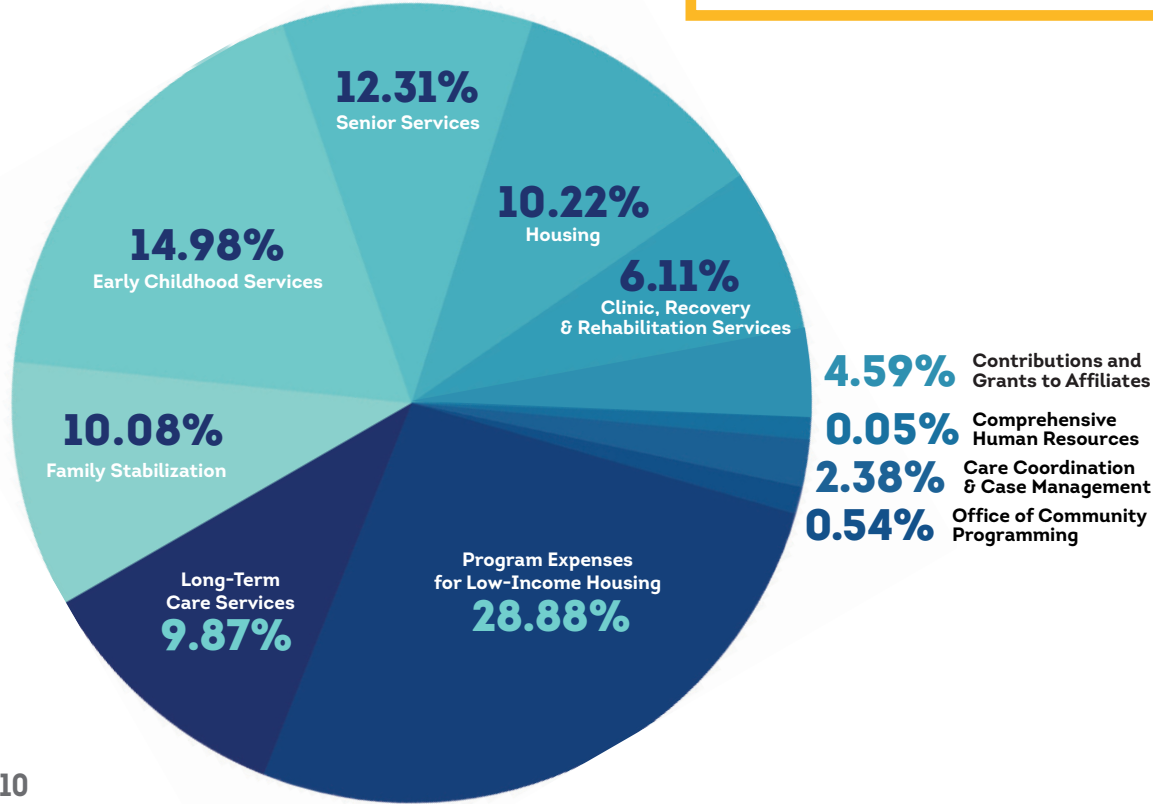
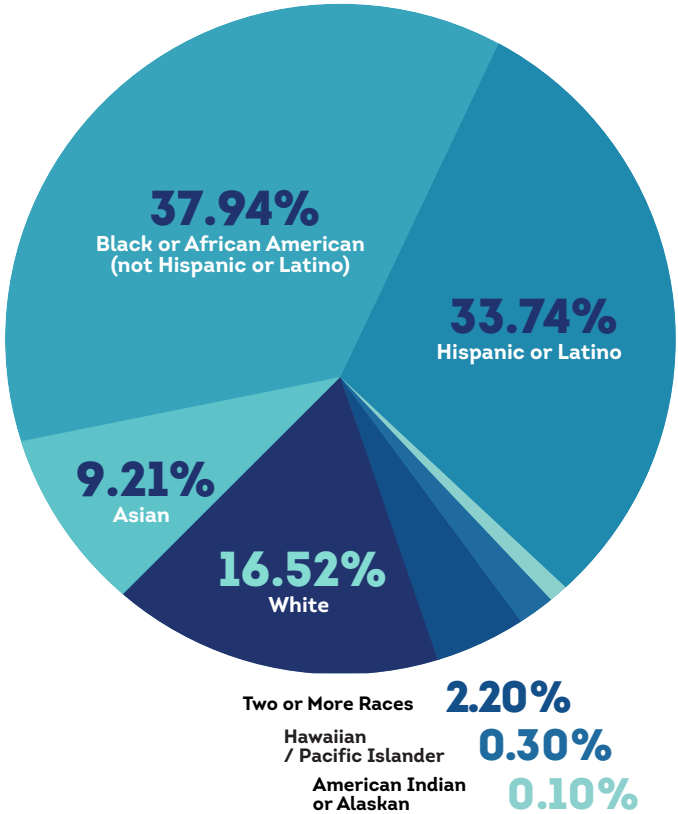
